**Jesus Christ** is the foundation and cornerstone of the church. He came to restore man's broken relationship with God. His finished work on the cross made that possible. (I Corinthians 3:11; Ephesians 2:20; Romans 5:6-10)

**The Bible** is the inspired, infallible Word of God and is relevant and applicable to man today. Therefore, we place great emphasis upon teaching it in public, studying it in private and using it as a guide for our daily lives. (I Timothy 4:13; II Timothy 3:16-17; I Thessalonians 5:6-10)

We believe that anyone who wills to come to Christ may do so.
- 3. "Positive confession"  $\sim$  The faith movement belief that God can be commanded to heal or work miracles according to man's will.
- 4. Human prophecy that supersedes the Scripture.
- 5. The incorporation of humanistic and secular psychology and philosophy into biblical teaching.
- 6. The over-emphasis of spiritual gifts, experiential signs and wonders to the exclusion of biblical teaching.
